In order to get the Early Registration Discount price:

- For 1 to 2 day classes: The full class price must be made by 1 month before the start of class. For refund purposes, this full payment is to be considered the 'deposit'.
- For longer classes: A deposits of \$300 / 280 EUR / 400 AUD must be made by 1 month before the start of class AND balances must be paid by 1 week before the start of class.

Late Payments:

If class tuition is not fully paid by 1 week before the start of class, it incurs a \$15 / 15 EUR / 20 AUD fee.

In the case of Cancellation:

- Refunds requested prior to a month before the class: full refund less admin fee of \$30 / 30 EUR / 40 AUD.
- Requested prior to 1 week before class: ½ the deposit refunded.
- Requested less than 1 week before class: the deposit is non-refundable.
- Any 'balance' payments, in excess of required 'deposits', are fully refundable.

Once class has begun, all tuition payments (deposits + balances) are non-refundable.

Late Arrivals on First Day may not be admitted to class and may be treated as a no-show. All tuition payments (deposits + balances) are Non-Refundable.

Early Departures: for class credit, students cannot miss any part of a class without teacher's ok.

If a student does not complete the class due to missed segments, tuition payments are non-refundable.

Exceptions, Children & Teenagers, and Repeaters:

Tuition for Children & Teenagers under 18 years old is 30% off.

Repeating a class a gets a 25% tuition discount, except for Deepening with Merlin, Deepening in Awakeness & Embodiment, and Deepening in Divinity classes.

Class Cancellation and Date-Change Policy

For a canceled class, full refunds will be given within a month of the date change, with no fees. Payments may be transferred, though, to another class upon request.

For a date-change, a full refund, with no fees, may be requested within 2 weeks of the announcement of the date change. After that, the usual cancellation policy applies.

Travel Costs: For an in-person class, airline tickets should not be purchased earlier than 3 months before an inperson class date. Life happens, and circumstances may force a cancellation or re-scheduling even closer than 3 months. In such situations, the student is responsible for the costs of canceled or re-booked travel arrangements and for any other costs incurred. The same policy applies if some kind of emergency forces Ric to leave in the middle of the class. Tuition payments will be fully refunded, but students will still be responsible for other costs incurred.

<u>Violation of Class Drug-Use Policy:</u> Student will need to drop out of class, with no refund of tuition.
